2017 Dodge Challenger / Challenger SRT Fact Sheet

New for 2017

- All-new Dodge Challenger T/A and Challenger T/A 392 models
 - Challenger T/A models bring even more performance and heritage-inspired styling to the naturally aspirated Dodge 5.7- and 6.4-liter 392 HEMI® lineup, including unique SRT Hellcat- and R/T Scat Pack-inspired functional performance styling for an even more menacing appearance
 - Unique Satin Black exterior graphics and appointments, including available hood pins on Challenger T/A, highlight Dodge brand's cultivation of its storied performance history
 - Wider, 20 x 9-inch and 20 x 9.5-inch wheels with high-performance Goodyear and Pirelli tires help improve handling on 5.7-liter and 392 HEMI-powered Dodge Challenger T/A models, respectively
 - Increased stopping power with ultra-high performance Brembo brakes with six-piston front and four-piston rear calipers on 392 HEMI-powered Challenger models
 - For the driving enthusiast, performance bolstered seats and Dodge performance steering wheel with available die-cast paddle shifters are included
 - New cold-air engine induction components unique to Challenger T/A models include:
 - New SRT Hellcat-inspired driver and passenger side "Air Catcher" headlamps add even more fresh air and feature unique LED-illuminated "T/A" logos
 - New directed cold-air hood system feeds a modified SRT Hellcat air box on Challenger T/A models
 - Mopar cold-air induction system with conical air filter included on all Challenger T/A models
- Active Exhaust now standard on all HEMI V-8 models
 - New for 2017, all 5.7-liter HEMI V-8 Challenger models, including T/A, feature a 2.75-inch electronically controlled active exhaust system to deliver a signature Dodge muscle-car sound
 - All-new fourth-generation Uconnect system debuts smartphone integrations available on all 2017 Dodge Challenger models:
 - Apple CarPlay enables iPhone users to access Apple Maps, messages, phone and Apple Music through Siri Voice control or the Uconnect 8.4-inch touchscreen
 - Android Auto enables easy and safe access to Google voice search, Google Maps and Google Play Music via the Uconnect 8.4-inch touchscreen or steering-wheel controls
 - New Uconnect system includes performance improvements with faster startup time, enhanced processing power, vivid imagery, plus higher resolution and sharper graphics
 - New 8.4-inch touchscreen with navigation offer multi-touch gestures with pinch, tap

and swipe capability

- SRT updates for 2017:
 - New 20 x 9.5-inch five-spoke “Lightweight 5Deep Aluminum” wheel design finished in Low Gloss Black is now standard, delivers 16 pounds of unsprung weight savings, improving dynamics on Challenger SRT Hellcat
 - New SRT Hellcat exterior and interior badging adds further distinction to the 2017 Dodge Challenger SRT Hellcat model
 - New SRT logo steering wheel features LED illumination in red (SRT Hellcat) or white (SRT 392) for an even more exclusive appearance at night
- Signature Houndstooth cloth seats are now standard on Dodge Challenger SXT, R/T, R/T Shaker and R/T Scat Pack models
- New Green Go (late availability), Yellow Jacket, Destroyer Grey and Octane Red exterior paints added to the lineup, while White Knuckle and Contusion Blue rename current production paint hues

August 31, 2016, Auburn Hills, Mich. - The Dodge Challenger is the most powerful muscle car ever. The 2017 Dodge Challenger SXT, with its standard powerful and fuel-efficient Pentastar V-6 engine and TorqueFlite eight-speed transmission, delivers 305 horsepower and an estimated 30 miles per gallon (mpg) on the highway. The Dodge Challenger R/T with the high-torque 5.7-liter HEMI paired with the TorqueFlite eight-speed or six-speed manual transmission delivers up to 375 horsepower. The 392 HEMI delivers 485 horsepower and 475 lb.-ft. of torque: the most horsepower and torque available for a U.S. Manufacturer’s Suggested Retail Price (MSRP) less than \$40,000. New for 2017, Dodge brings back the Challenger T/A to the naturally aspirated Dodge 5.7- and 392 HEMI lineup. Features include a new active exhaust system, wider wheels, performance tires, cold-air induction components, including new SRT Hellcat-inspired driver and passenger side “Air Catcher” headlamps featuring unique LED-illuminated T/A logos. Available hood pins are designed to highlight the Dodge brand’s cultivation of its storied performance history. The Dodge Challenger T/A 392 adds six-piston Brembo front brakes. The SRT 392 features adaptive damping suspension and SRT Drive Modes. The Challenger SRT Hellcat with its 707-horsepower supercharged 6.2-liter HEMI V-8 engine is the most powerful and fastest muscle car ever.

- Both the T/A 392 and Challenger SRT models feature the largest front-brake package ever offered in a FCA US vehicle, 390-mm (15.4-inch) Brembo two-piece rotors with six-piston calipers, for outstanding heat management, thermal capacity and longevity
- SRT Drive Modes allow the driver to tailor their driving experience by controlling horsepower, transmission shift speeds, steering (Challenger SRT 392), paddle shifters (automatic transmission), traction and suspension. Drive Modes are pre-configured for Sport, Track and Default modes, while Custom mode lets drivers tailor the drive experience to their favorite settings
- Dodge Challenger R/T Scat Pack, Challenger T/A 392 and 392 HEMI Scat Pack Shaker punch out 485

naturally aspirated horsepower and 475 lb.-ft. of torque with six-speed manual or TorqueFlite eight-speed automatic transmission, Brembo brakes and 20 x 9-inch aluminum wheels

- 392 HEMI Scat Pack Shaker model combines the ultimate combination of power and heritage cues with a functional Shaker hood
- TorqueFlite eight-speed automatic transmission and 305-horsepower Pentastar V-6 enable up to an estimated 30 mpg on the highway, plus precision and enhanced performance, thanks to sport mode and paddle-shifting capabilities on Challenger SXT and SXT Plus models
- Dodge brand's popular Blacktop Appearance Group enhances 2017 Dodge Challenger SXT and R/T models' sinister look with blacked out features
- The 1971-inspired Challenger muscle-car exterior styling with split grille, pronounced and functional power bulge hood, LED halo headlamps and LED tail lamps
- Interior design features 1971-inspired high-sill center console and driver-focused instrument panel available in 13 different exterior colors and a wide variety of interior trim selections, including throwback Houndstooth cloth to Ruby Red, Tungsten or Pearl with Black leather performance seats
- More than 70 available safety and security features, including Forward Collision Warning, adaptive cruise control, Blind-spot Monitoring and Rear Cross Path detection
