2017 Dodge Charger / Charger SRT Fact Sheet

New for 2017

- All-new Dodge Charger Daytona and Daytona 392 models
 - New 2017 Charger Daytona models offer even more performance and heritage-inspired styling to the naturally aspirated 5.7- and 6.4-liter 392 HEMI® lineup, including unique SRT Hellcat-inspired functional performance styling for an even more menacing appearance
 - Unique Daytona Satin Black exterior hood, roof and deck-lid graphics, a Satin Black spoiler, and unique interior seats and finishes
 - Wider, 20 x 9-inch and 20 x 9.5-inch wheels with high-performance Goodyear and Pirelli tires help improve handling on 5.7-liter and 392 HEMI-powered Dodge Charger Daytona models, respectively
 - Increased stopping power with performance brake pads on 5.7-liter Dodge Charger Daytona models, while 392 HEMI Daytona models add an ultra-high performance Brembo brake system with six-piston front and four-piston rear brake calipers
 - For the driving enthusiast, unique “Daytona” embroidered performance bolstered seats and Dodge performance steering wheel with die-cast paddle shifters are included
- Active Exhaust now standard on all HEMI V-8 models
 - New for 2017, all 5.7-liter HEMI V-8 Charger models, including Daytona, feature a 2.75-inch electronically controlled active exhaust system to deliver a signature Dodge muscle-car sound
- All-new fourth-generation 8.4-inch Uconnect system

 - New SRT logo steering wheel features LED illumination in red (SRT Hellcat) or white (SRT 392)

- New Green Go (late availability), Yellow Jacket, Destroyer Grey and Octane Red exterior paints added to the lineup, while White Knuckle and Contusion Blue rename current production paint hues

Its rear-wheel-drive architecture enables a model lineup highlighted by extensive performance-driven powertrains with the latest technology under the hood and behind the wheel – further building on the Dodge brand's promise to deliver American performance machines with world-class power, efficiency, technology, authentic materials and standout styling. New for 2017, Dodge builds on its heritage, introducing new Charger Daytona models designed to deliver more performance and heritage-inspired styling to the naturally aspirated Dodge 5.7-liter and 392 HEMI lineup.

The innovative TorqueFlite eight-speed automatic transmission is standard on every Dodge Charger model. New for 2017, Active Exhaust is now standard on all HEMI V-8 models. The Charger also offers a full range of fuel-efficient and powerful engine options. The award-winning 3.6-liter V-6 Pentastar engine delivers up to 30 miles per gallon (mpg) on SE and SXT models. The legendary 5.7-liter HEMI V-8 on the R/T and Daytona delivers 370 horsepower. The 6.4-liter HEMI V-8 punches out a best-in-class, naturally aspirated 485 horsepower and 475 lb.-ft. of torque in the R/T Scat Pack, Daytona 392 and SRT 392 models. For ultimate performance, the 6.2-liter supercharged Charger SRT Hellcat delivers 707 horsepower, 650 lb.-ft. of torque, a top speed of 204 miles per hour (mph), National Hot Rod Association (NHRA)-certified, quarter-mile elapsed time of 11.0 seconds on street tires and 0-60 mph in the high 3-second range, making it the quickest, fastest and most powerful sedan in the world.

Drive Modes are pre-configured for Sport, Track and Default settings, while Custom mode lets the driver select their favorites
- Charger SRT models feature three-mode Bilstein adaptive damping suspension, featuring Auto, Sport and Track modes
- Dodge Charger R/T Scat Pack model offers the most horsepower under \$40,000 U.S. Manufacturer's Suggested Retail Price (MSRP), featuring a 392 HEMI V-8, which punches out a best-in-class, naturally aspirated 485 horsepower and 475 lb.-ft. of torque and features Dodge Performance Pages, Brembo brakes and 20-by-9-inch aluminum wheels
- Dodge brand's popular Blacktop Appearance Group enhances the 2017 Dodge Charger SE, SXT and R/T models' sinister appearance with a "blacked out" look
- Dodge Charger SE AWD and SXT AWD models include the segment's most technologically advanced

all-wheel-drive (AWD) system with a segment-exclusive active transfer case and front-axle-disconnect system to improve real-world fuel economy

- Efficient TorqueFlite eight-speed transmission is standard on all models and enables 30 mpg best-in-class V-6 highway fuel economy, 27 mpg best-in-class AWD V-6 fuel economy and maximum performance with 160 millisecond shifts and rev-matching on SRT 392 and SRT Hellcat
- Super Track Pak delivers a full complement of race-bred chassis upgrades that include a 0.5 inch lower ride height, Bilstein shock absorbers, 3.07 rear axle ratio (V-6) and Dodge Performance Pages, which provide visible performance information, such as programmable shift light indicator, reaction time, 0-60 mph times, G-force indicator and lap times
- Charger offers more than 80 available safety and security features, including Full-speed Forward Collision Warning – Plus, Adaptive Cruise Control – Plus with Full Stop, Lane Departure Warning with Lane Keep Assist
- Charger's available segment-exclusive BeatsAudio system immerses passengers in the ultimate audio experience with 552-watt amplifier and trunk-mounted subwoofer
