- Alfa Romeo – the heart and soul of the automotive industry – returns to the U.S. with an all-new lineup of vehicles, starting with the award-winning 4C Coupe and 4C Spider, and now the all-new Giulia premium mid-size sedan
- As the lineup's "halo" model, Giulia Quadrifoglio highlights Alfa Romeo's performance and motorsport knowhow with best-in-class 505 horsepower, 0-60 miles per hour (mph) in 3.8 seconds and a record-setting 7:32 lap time around the legendary Nürburgring – fastest ever by a four-door production sedan
- Alfa Romeo Giulia and Giulia Ti models feature an all-new, all-aluminum, 2.0-liter, direct-injection turbo engine with eight-speed automatic transmission delivers a class-leading, standard 280 horsepower and 306 lb.-ft. of torque, allowing it to launch from 0-60 mph in less than 5.1 seconds, and achieve a top speed of 149 mph
- All three Giulia models offer:
 - Near perfect 50/50 weight distribution, segment-leading torsional rigidity and the most direct steering ratio on the market, thanks to Giulia's all-new rear-wheel-drive architecture
 - Unique Italian style and craftsmanship to the premium mid-size sedan segment
 - A 55-year heritage of Alfa Romeo's lightweight, performance sedan tradition and more than 105 years of brand history, carving its legend on road courses around the globe
- Crafted by Alfa Romeo artisans at the Cassino plant in Frosinone, Italy

As the first of a new generation of vehicles on an all-new platform, the [2017 Alfa Romeo Giulia](#) and Giulia Ti models embody Alfa Romeo's La meccanica delle emozioni (the mechanics of emotion) spirit, delivering race-inspired performance with a class-leading 280 horsepower, advanced technologies that include the available Alfa Q4 all-wheel-drive system, seductive Italian style and an exhilarating driving experience to the premium mid-size sedan segment. As the "halo" model in the lineup, Giulia Quadrifoglio highlights Alfa Romeo's motorsport knowhow with a best-in-class, 505-horsepower, 2.9-liter twin-turbo V-6 engine that earns the title of the most powerful Alfa Romeo production car engine ever and the quickest with a class-leading 0-60 mph time of 3.8 seconds, plus it enabled a record-setting 7:32 Nürburgring lap time – the fastest ever by a four-door production sedan.

Highlights

- An all-new eight-speed automatic transmission, with available column-mounted paddle shifters, is designed for enthusiasts with gear shifts in less than 100 milliseconds
- Giulia and Giulia Ti models are available with the segment's most technologically advanced AWD system, which includes a segment-exclusive active transfer case and front-axle-disconnect system to improve real-world fuel economy. This advanced AWD system seamlessly transitions between rear-wheel drive (RWD) and AWD with no drive intervention to maximize fuel economy
- As the pinnacle of the Alfa Romeo lineup, the Giulia Quadrifoglio features a best-in-class power-to-weight ratio of around 7 pounds per horsepower and exclusive enhancements for maximum performance, including high-performance front and rear fascias and lightweight carbon fiber materials, including hood, active aero front splitter, rocker panel moldings and rear deck-lid spoiler

- For drivers who want even more performance from Alfa Romeo, the Giulia Quadrifoglio's 505-horsepower V-6 twin-turbo engine makes this vehicle the most powerful Alfa Romeo production car ever, delivering 0-60 miles per hour (mph) in 3.8 seconds and a top speed of 191 mph, while a cylinder deactivation system reduces real-world fuel consumption by up to 15 percent
- State-of-the-art technologies exclusive to Giulia Quadrifoglio include torque vectoring, active aero front splitter and Alfa DNA Pro mode selector with Race mode, Brembo six-piston front and four-piston rear brake caliper system, Quadrifoglio-tuned adaptive suspension, Quadrifoglio instrument cluster with 200 mph speedometer, cylinder deactivation system, Blind-spot Monitoring, Rear Cross Path detection, vehicle alarm and high-performance bi-xenon headlamps offering auto-leveling technology, adaptive cornering and headlamp washers
