The new 2007 Chrysler Pacifica features a new 4.0-litre aluminum V-6 engine mated to a new six-speed automatic transmission, updated exterior styling, more standard equipment, including all-row side-curtain air bags and Electronic Stability Program (ESP), and an average Canadian Manufacturer's Suggested Retail Price (MSRP) of roughly \$3,050 less than outgoing models.

The starting Canadian MSRP of the new 2007 Chrysler Pacifica is \$34,440 (plus a \$1,200 destination fee). It will begin to arrive in dealerships this fall.

The Chrysler Pacifica offers exceptional value for an entry-level sports tourer with a Canadian MSRP starting at \$34, 440 (plus a \$1,200 destination fee).
